

HEIRLOOM LICENCE APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Application made on 'Application for – Collectors / Antique / Heirloom* - Licence' – PF481.
- The applicant has completed all parts of the form.
- The applicant has signed and dated the application.
- The applicant has provided 100 points of identification ('Proof of Identity' – PF490).
- The applicant has provided evidence that they own the firearm(s) to be held on the licence, or it has been given or bequeathed to them.
- The applicant has provided evidence that the firearm(s) to be held on the licence has significant historical or sentimental lineage to the applicant or the applicant's family.
- The applicant has produced a NT Police certificate that the firearms(s) to be held on the licence have been deactivated, or the applicant has surrendered the firearm for inspection to be certified as deactivated.
- The applicant has provided written details of how they are going to store firearms to comply with the requirements of the Act and Regulations. No inspection is required unless directed by the Officer in Charge, Firearms Policy and Records Unit.
- The application has been added to SAFER, including if required, a PROMIS ID being created.
- A Photograph of the applicant has been obtained in accordance with the approved method.
- A PROMIS and IJIS check have been completed and the results noted in the provided fields on the rear of the application form.
- The receiving member has signed the application.
